OTHER SHOW INFORMATION

Horses need not be registered to enter the show, however, all horses must measure 58" or under in height (14.2 hands).

The show management reserves the right to measure any horses in question, to determine eligibility or applicable division. Miniatures are measured at the last hair of the mane. Ponies are measured at the withers.

Entry Procedure: In the case of youth entries, a parent or legal guardian must also sign the entry form. Payment of all fees must accompany entries.

Refunds: Refund of entry fees for a horse's illness will be made ONLY with a valid signed Veterinarian's certificate stating horses' inability to show, submitted day of or before actual show date.

Two Minute Gate Call: Once a class is given the final call, the gate will be closed in two (2) minutes and no late exhibitor will be accepted into the ring. Final call is considered to be when the first horse enters the ring for the class. The two-minute call will be strictly enforced. NO refunds will be given for missed classes.

Tack Change: Exhibitors needing extra time between classes must request a tack change at the in-gate two classes before their expected delay.

Adding or Scratching Classes: Adding or Scratching classes needs to be done 3 classes prior to class in question.

Pre-Entry Fees: Entries must post marked on or before *July 5, 2007*, to be eligible for pre-entry fees. Post marked entries received after *July 5, 2007*, will be charged post-entry fees.

Arrival: Show personnel and staff will be available for check-in beginning at 6:30 am on Saturday July 21, 2007. This is a one-day, trailer in show. The show is held in an outdoor arena.

Hospitality: Picnic lunches are welcome. Food is available nearby. Handicapped accessible restrooms available.

Dogs: Our club insurance does not cover dogs. Please leave pets at home. *Thanks!*

Turn left onto CR 21 / Cummings Ave. Continue to follow Cummings Ave for approx 1 mile. Turn left onto CR 16 (portions unpaved) (follow approx 0.2 mi). End at 3756 West CR 16.
